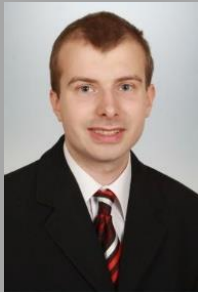



Bachelor Students: Approximately 10 pages (excluding title page, table of contents, references, figures)

LNCS Style

Phase 1: Review of two other seminar papers

Output:

- Two review reports

Phase 2: Improvement of own seminar paper based on review reports

Output:

- Revised seminar paper
- Rejoinder document

Masters Students: 20 min. presentation (hard deadline!)

10 min. questions & answers session and comments on presentation style

Bachelor Students: 15 min. presentation (hard deadline!)

10 min. questions & answers session and comments on presentation style

- Topic not addressed
- Plagiarism
- Missed deadlines
- No attendance in seminar talks
- Seminar paper has low level of quality (grammar, spelling, content)
- Bad presentation
- Ignoring further rules and guidelines (review, presentation)

1. Supervisors will present their topics
2. Students have the chance to approach potential supervisors -> 23rd is application deadline
3. Supervisor and coordinator select one student per topic -> April 24th
